Calling all couples thinking of getting married!

Did you know that since October 2009, the Church of England has relaxed its rules so more of you can now get married in Grayswood church even if neither of you lives in parish and you're not on the (church) electoral roll?

The only thing you now need is what's called a 'qualifying connection'. So, if

- you have lived here <u>at any time</u> or attended worship here for at least 6 months
- your name is in the Grayswood Baptism or Confirmation register
- one or both of your parents have lived here <u>at</u> <u>any time during your lifetime</u> or attended worship here regularly (either for at least 6 months)
- a parent or grandparent was married here

That's certainly good news for us, as it means we don't have to say 'no' to so many people who would like to get married here. We hope it's good news for you too. We're a relaxed, friendly church family and look forward to hearing from you and helping you prepare for your wedding. Contact me or Janet in the office (details over)
