

11 November 2018 marks the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War.

I was fortunate enough to be able to catch the Luxmuralis installation at Guildford Cathedral in October. The nave was cleared and the whole Cathedral was projected with poppies. A video of Eddie Redmayne reading a selection of war poetry added to the atmosphere and the Regimental chapel had a rolling list of the names of the 18,000 servicemen from Surrey who had died in the conflict.

It was a very moving experience and made me think of my own grandfather. He fought in the Great War although he never talked about his experiences, probably due to the horror of what he'd witnessed. It made me realise that as we move forward it is more important than ever to keep alive the memory of all those who died - especially as future generations will have less first hand connections to make it as real.

The numbers who died in that war are incomprehensible in today's world but without their bravery we would be living in a very different UK. I hope that wherever you are on Sunday 11th November at 11 o'clock that you will stop and spend 2 minutes thinking of those who served and those who never returned home. Love Fix

ALL WHO SERVED, SACRIFICED, and changed our world 1918-2018

Some of you may have been to see the 'Haslemere remembers' exhibition at St Christopher's in September, a poignant reminder of the pain caused by war. In the past weeks you may have also have noticed poppy wreaths appearing around Haslemere. These have been sponsored by our Town Council. Each one has been placed near a home that lost a soldier.

The names of those who gave their lives in the great wars are read out in church and at the Grayswood War Memorial each year. This year we will start our Remembrance Service in All Saints Church at 10.50am and we will join with the nation in a two minute silence at 11.00am. Following the service we will process up Grayswood Road to the War Memorial and the wreaths that have been on display in Grayswood will be laid at the memorial as each name is read out.



We hope that you will join others from the village to take time out from the 'busyness' of life to pause, give thanks and honour those who lost their lives, or suffered mental and physical scars for the rest of their lives, because they stepped up to the challenge and went to war to fight for the preservation of peace.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning. We will remember them.
