## PENTECOST SERVICE

It was so lovely to be able to welcome the children from Grayswood School back into the Church Building on Wednesday.

Separated into age groups to keep everyone safe, we learned how the Holy Spirit was a gift given to Jesus' Disciples at the Festival of Pentecost. We heard how the Spirit arrived as a rushing wind and with tongues of fire, and so the church was decorated with paper flames and stained glass designs that the children had made during the week.

The children added pieces of fruit to our Pentecost tree - each marked with one of the fruits of the Spirit : love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Revd Fi Gwynn reminded everyone that "The Holy



Spirit helps us to grow in all these things as we grow in closeness to God and become more like Jesus."

The service concluded with prayers read by the children: "God our Father, It is in you that we live and move and have our being. Inspire us to live in such a way that our choices each day will lead us to faithfully live the present moment, and transform the ordinariness of everyday life into something extraordinary. Bless us this day and always. Amen" (Year 4 Prayer)
