Our PCC worked with local designer, Julie Fox, to produce a branding inspired by the cross on the church lych gate. The scrollwork ends on the arms of the cross were reimagined as heart motifs to reflect our three-fold motto of love "For God, for one another, [and] for the world". These hearts, so common in Scandinavian designs, also give a nod to our Swedish architect, Axel Haig (Hägg).
