Florists & Decorators

- The florist will have access to the church three hours before the scheduled time of the wedding or the previous day by prior agreement.
- Flowers and decorations must be in place at least one hour before the service begins.
- All flowers and decorations must be removed from the facilities immediately after the wedding ceremony by the florist or designated person. Pedestals may be left by prior agreement with the priest.
- If the lych gate or porch are decorated, floral decorations must be removed within 2 working days of the wedding ceremony taking place.
- You must use discretion in your floral decorations. Absolutely no wire, tape, glue, staples, nails or tacks are to be used to fasten any decorations to the furniture, floor, or walls of this listed building.
- Existing decorations or furnishings within the church must not be moved in order to use them as decoration for weddings.
- All policies and restrictions that apply to the florist also apply to any friend or member of the family planning to provide floral arrangements and decorations.
