
Light up the village

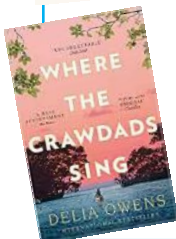
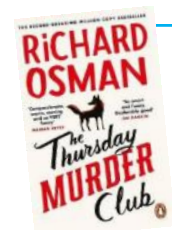

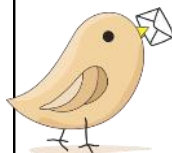
Runner by Post
