For the sake of Jesus, who died for us,  
forgive us for all that is past,  
and help us to live each day  
in the light of Christ our Lord.  
Amen.**

*The minister declares God's forgiveness*

**Praise**

The love of God has been poured into our hearts  
through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

*All*    **We dwell in him and he in us.**

*All* Give thanks to the Lord and call upon his name,  
**make known his deeds among the peoples.**

*All* Sing to him, sing praises to him,  
**and speak of all his marvellous works.**

*All* Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God almighty,  
**who was and is and is to come.**

*This Canticle may be said:*

Come, worship God who is worthy of honour,  
Enter his presence with thanks and a song!  
He is the rock of his people's salvation,  
To whom our jubilant praises belong.

*All* **Ruled by his might are the heights of the mountains,  
Held in his hands are the depths of the earth;  
His is the sea, his the land for he made them,  
King above all gods, who gave us our birth.**

We are his people, the sheep of his pasture,  
He is our maker and to him we pray;  
Gladly we kneel in obedience before him –  
Great is the God whom we worship this day!

the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,
