Message from Isabelle Cole

It is my privilege to be your Lib Dem Town Councillor and I felt very honoured to have been elected in 2019 - but I shall not be standing again in 2023, because I really feel that it should be somebody younger and ideally more digitally able than I am - and as long as they have the interests of Grayswood and its community at heart, I don't think that it really matters which political party, if any, they belong to.


I stood in 2019 because I believe in choice and diversity - and because before those local elections, only 1 of the 18 Haslemere Town Councillors was not a Conservative! I never imagined I'd get elected but I was - along with 6 other Lib Dems, 2 Greens and 2 Independents who, together with 7 Conservatives, have made Haslemere Town Council far more representative and better balanced.

It has been an interesting experience and a rather frustrating one, money being tight and red tape abundant ... To date my only achievement as a Town Councillor has been the noticeboard in the redundant bus shelter by the Grayswood Club! I hope that my successor will have more luck than me in getting lidded litterbins installed on the Village Green; in getting the uneven footway in front of the Prestwick Lane houses resurfaced. These are all issues which I have tried and so far disappointingly failed to resolve.

Meanwhile I hope that having worked long and hard to secure from Surrey County Council the assurance of a 'lollipop lady' or man for our School, someone applies for the job!

Unlike a lollipop lady, a Town Councillor is unpaid and can claim no expenses - but for the sake of local democracy I really hope that someone from Grayswood will come forward as a candidate. I envisage possibly someone recently retired or an 'empty nester' whose family has left home: someone with time on their hands and needing a new focus, someone with the interests of our village and its community at heart.
