At the end of June, I accompanied the Year 6 pupils from Grayswood School on a visit to Wintershall's Life of Christ.

Despite a challenging start to the day, (the coach that should have been picking us up hit a tree) we finally made it to Wintershall. Amazingly, we only missed the first 10 minutes thanks to the speedy assistance of Mr Dean from Grayswood Nursery School.

If you have never been, the premise is that the Life of Christ, from the annunciation to the ascension, is performed by a cast of over 100, many of whom are children, in a number of scenes enacted in the grounds of the Wintershall Estate. It takes place over 5 hours with a break for a picnic lunch in the middle. The actors intermingle with the audience and the settings for the scenes, including several scenes on the lake, make the story of Christ come to life.

The children really enjoyed their day, and unsurprisingly the majority thought that the crucifixion was the best part! For those of us who watch with more mature eyes, it is an extremely emotional and harrowing scene.

The visit was made possible thanks to a grant from the Godalming Deanery Fund, which meant we could offer it to the pupils without charge. A huge thank you to Angela Wheeler, one of our members of the Deanery Synod who applied for the grant on our behalf.

The children and staff are all now looking forward to the summer holidays and a much deserved break.

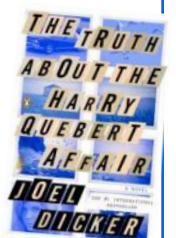
