## **ELECTORAL ROLL REVISION**

As with all churches, we need to produce a new Electoral Roll every 6 years. All Saints is due to be completed in April 2025. ALL Church members need to register.

The Church's Electoral Roll is the register of its voting members—a list of those qualified to attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting and provides an indication of the real membership and strength of the church.
