Diocesan Synod is the primary governing body for the diocese, acting as a kind of 'parliament' for our parishes and churches. It is made up of around 120 representatives, including bishops, clergy, and laypeople. Diocesan Synods are elected every three years by members of Deanery Synods. The Synod meets three times a year to share ideas, hold conversations, and make decisions on key policies. It also plays a crucial role in shaping national conversations in the Church of England by sending representatives to the national General Synod. **Please pray for Fi as she stands for election to Synod**
